Noah's Kitchen House Policy for the service of alcohol

- Noah's Kitchen Pty Ltd promotes and practices the responsible consumption of liquor in accordance with the liquor act 1992 and the liquor regulation 2002.
- Noah's Kitchen Pty Ltd is committed to the training and support of staff in the Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA).
- Queensland law prohibits the consumption or purchase of liquor by persons who are **minors, unduly intoxicated** or **disorderly**.
- If a staff member is of the opinion that a patron is unduly intoxicated or disorderly, the staff member must not serve liquor to that person.
- Customers deemed to be unduly intoxicated will be refused service, offered water and a taxi will be called if required.
- Patrons and staff must treat each other with dignity and courtesy at all times.
- Patrons who are rude or offensive to staff or other patrons will be refused service and asked to leave the premises.
- Minors may be on the premises if in the care of a responsible adult or guardian, but may not consume or purchase liquor.
- It is a condition of entry that patrons purchasing or consuming liquor must produce photo ID showing proof of age if asked by a staff member.
- Any patron attempting to consume or purchase alcohol who cannot provide proof of age will be refused service.
- Security staff may be needed for certain functions and left to the discretion of Noah's Kitchen Pty Ltd. The cost to be paid by the client.
- Noah's Kitchen Pty Ltd or staff may refuse service to **ANY** person for **ANY** reason at **ANY** time.
